

General Information Regarding EasyTech by Learning.com

I thought I would share a few things with you that should help get you going!

1. You are assigned to a building. EC Elementary, EC Intermediate, or EC Junior High. Teachers of both Junior High and High School were put with Junior High since the curriculum is K thru 8. Teachers for both Intermediate and Junior High were put where they are housed.
2. I have included screenshots of the login. (see below) Go to www.learning.com. (You may want to add this to your favorites.) *Usernames* for teachers are your standard usernames you have been using. Teacher *password* is “usual teacher password as assigned by technology department.” District is East Chambers ISD.
3. Once you have logged in, you will see your Account Information. (see below) You will notice an EDIT button. Click here to change your password if desired.
4. Next, you should complete the 4 tutorials. (see below) The link to the tutorials can be found under News & Events on your Teacher Home Page. The tutorials aren't very long and should be informative.
5. Below the tutorial links on the Implementation Help page, you will see a link to Scope and Sequence, as well as Teacher Guides and a few other items you may find beneficial. I also have hard copies of the Teacher Guides (3 for each grade level) that can be checked out.

In addition, there are some good links on the SetupHelp page.

6. After the initial information gathering, you should be ready to create your classes and add students to each class, then you will be ready to preview and assign curriculum. Depending on whether or not you want your students tracked will determine if you want a shared username and password for the class. If you are tracking, you won't need the shared items, each student will use their unique student ID as their username. You will NOT need to create a student account; it has been done for you. All you will need to do is enroll the students in your classes from the school roster.
7. Be patient for data to upload. Sometimes it takes a little while.
8. Please let me know if you have a new student that is NOT already on the student roster and needs to be added so you can enroll them. We have a limited number of licenses for users, and we have to stay on top of this.
9. Additionally you may want to check out the Classroom Tools page which has login cards, computer sign-up sheets, etc. You may find something beneficial here. (You can find the link to the Classroom Tools page on the Implementation page at the top of the page.)



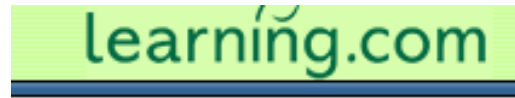
